

Ready to Sprint

This coming weekend March 27/28th the KORR team will be competing in the first round of the all new ACU British Sprint Enduro Championship near Tewksbury, Gloucestershire. Last year the very first UK Sprint Enduro was held at Rhyader in mid Wales where Daryl Bolter (Premier Bikes) and Greg Evans (Wayne Mounter M/C's) finished 1st and 2nd overall on their 250EXC-F's, so this weekend both riders will be looking to win again.

This year we also have young expert rider James Giddings on his Premier Bikes 125EXC who will be looking to build on his recent success, having just won overall the REME Winter Hare N Hounds series. Each week James improves his level as he builds confidence on his 125 KTM and is hoping for top honours in the Expert class.

At the sharp end Daryl and Greg will have more competition this year in the shape of KTM'S double World champion David Knight and Husaberg Factory rider Joakim Ljunggren from Sweden and many other UK teams keen to experience this exciting form of Enduro racing.

The KORR Team will also be supporting World Indoor Enduro champion , Polish Extreme specialist Taddy Blazusiak who is flying in to use the event to improve his special test speed as he wishes to contest the first WEC rounds in Spain and Portugal next month.

This will be Taddy's first serious outing on a 250 4 stroke and the team have prepared something special for him, look out for the "Red Rooster" as he is known in Poland, he will certainly entertain the crowd with his all action Whiskey throttle style !!!.
