ASHDOWN PRACTICE TRACK

The Archway Project is a small charity based in Thamesmead, London. Established in 1982, we work to improve the lives of young people living in the city, including those at risk of anti-social behaviour and those who may not be doing very well at school, either due to problems at home or because of mild learning difficulties like dyslexia.

Activities at the Archway Project centre on off road motorbike mechanics and riding. Young people are taught the theory as well as practical mechanics in the workshop. Our members carry out simple repairs through to complete engine rebuilds, and maintain our fleet of motorbikes that are used during off road riding trips.

We also teach cooking and photography, and arrange trips to motorsport events such as the Weston Beach Race and British Motocross Grand Prix, so that our members can watch their sporting heroes in action. Through all of these activities, we equip young people with both qualifications and life skills to help them lead meaningful futures.

Supplementary Regulations

Announcement Archway Project Motorcycle Club are holding on the Saturday 7th August 2010 a Hare n Hounds enduro event to be held under the National Sporting Code and the safety code of OPRA.

Jurisdiction: Held under the National Sporting Code and Standing Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any Final Instructions that may be issued.

Eligibility: Open to all. All riders must hold an ORPA license issued by ORPA. One day event licences will be available (price £3) if a rider does not hold a valid 2010 competition license.

Venue & Start: Ashdown Practice track. Ashdown practice track is situated off the A417 between Blewbury and Streatley, take the track signposted to 'The Downs' which is opposite Halfpenny Lane and the Cholsey road. Follow this track which turns into the Fair Mile and as the ground opens up the course is on the right through the gate.

The event will take place entirely on private land. Course approximately 3.5 miles. The course will be marked with tape and arrows.

The 2 hour youth race start will be at 9.30am.
Signing on 7.30 – 8.45am. Scrutineering 8.00 – 9.00am

Bikes: All bikes need to be presented to the scrutineer and must display clear number front & sides. Youth race will not accept engine size above 250cc four-stroke and 125cc two stroke.

Entries: Open 2nd May. Close 30th July 2010. STRICKLY NO ENTRIES ON THE DAY
Each entry to be sent to the secretary of the meeting on the entry form on these regulations enclosing the appropriate entry fee. We require two stamped addressed envelopes. Cheques should be made payable to "Archway Project Ltd." Entries are restricted to 180 riders. No entries to be sent recorded delivery.
