at Arncott. OX25 1NZ

This event is held under the National Sporting Code of the Auto-Cycle Union, the Standing Hare & Hounds /Cross Country Regulations. These Supplementary Regulations and any Final Instructions issued for the meeting. The ACU National Sporting Code and Standing Regulations are published annually in the ACU Handbook. Status: Three Counties MXC will promote an OPEN Hare & Hounds Cross Country Event open to riders who hold a valid ACU or SACU Licence.

Definition: Hare & Hounds is a controlled Group Start event which is a test of endurance and reliability. Competitors will be required to complete a number of laps within a time set by the organisers (Not less than 2 hours).

Eligibility: ALL Riders must hold an ACU or SACU Licence and be a minimum of 16 years for adult events. Riders under 18 years require parental agreement form with entry form. ACU Licence will be checked on signing on. If you require a One Event day licence to be issued on the day you will need to send and extra £ 10.00 with your entry fee. In Post or applied for, will not be accepted.

Venue: Arncott Track (through Arncott Village) near Bicester, Oxon. OX25 1NZ. Event will be signposted with orange arrows from Arncott Village.

Start: all riders 12.00 p.m..

Entries: Must be on the correct ACU headed entry form together with the correct fee of £ 35.00 . A requirement of signing an entry application form is that each signatory understands the National Sporting Code of the ACU to be returned to the Secretary of the event with the correct fee. Close when full. Entries limited to a maximum of 80 riders. Day Entries £ 5.00 extra Day Licence Available £ 10.00

Course: Multi-lap event, perimeter of field plus Motocross track with manmade obstacles.

Machines: Must be presented to the machine examiner at least 30 minutes before the start then placed in the start area in the class start line applicable to the rider completing.

Noise: MX 4 stroke machine MUST be fitted with an Enduro FIM spec silencer or approved DBA reducer. MX bikes fitted with excessively noisy exhaust systems will be turned away.

Refuelling: Can only be done in the official refuelling area by riders, officials and authorised helpers. NO CHILDREN IN PIT/REFUELING AREA. All engines MUST be stopped during refuelling. Refueling outside the official refuelling area will result in exclusion from the event with NO exceptions. Outside assistance will only be allowed in the pit area, except when provided by the organisers. BLUE TAPE AREAS WALKING PACE ONLY.

Lap Scoring: The competitors will pass through a BLUE TAPE AREA at the end of each lap where the competitors passage will be recorded by lap scoring officials. Riders numbers must be displayed on front & sides of machine and be clearly visible. Please ensure front number is stuck on firmly, **officials may need to clean your number. SESSION DETAILS TO BE CONFIRMED ON THE DAY.**
